FASHION PARADE / RUNWAY SHOW



They will work with selected fashion businesses to produce an entertaining and on brand runway show, supporting the Gala event overall theme. The littlelion team will also manage this main stage working with MC's, DJs and other entertainment.
- The runway show is likely to be repeated two or three times throughout the event subject to final programming.
- The number of garments per trader will be confirmed, but likely to fall somewhere between 5 to 10 looks per trader.
- A runway will be located at the Park/Mitchell Street intersection of King William Road.

EVENT AND PERMIT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Event Terms and Conditions

Traders selected to participate in the Unley Gala Fashion Parade / Runway Show must abide by the below event terms and conditions.

- 1. It is the trader's responsibility to provide and check off social media handles
- 2. Best endeavours will be made to take care of your garments, with all models wearing change scarves and care taken around fake tans
- 3. All garments must be delivered and collected by the trader as per the instructions to be provided by the Producer
- 4. If it rains during the runway show, the Producer will make the call if the runway show is cancelled at whatever time the stage becomes unsafe to models and/or your garments. Remaining sections or shows will not be made up at a later time if they are cancelled due to weather
- Traders are asked to not come backstage during the shows unless previously organised by the Parade Producer director or stylist
- 6. If fine jewellery is supplied, the trader must be responsible for their jewellery at all times which includes having a dedicated person who will put pieces on and off models and take full responsibility for the jewellery over the duration of the entire event
- 7. Creative execution is at the discretion of the Producer who has been appointed to produce the runway show

- 8. If shoes are supplied, they must be supplied already taped
- Traders are requested to comply with all directions given by the Parade Producer, employee, agent or authorized officer of the Council or a member of the SA Police

10. Indemnity and Release

- 10.1 The trader agrees to indemnify the Council from and against all actions, costs, claims and damages, which may be brought or claimed against the Council arising directly or indirectly out of or in relation to the fashion parade/runway show
- 10.2 The trader agrees to release the Council from liability or claim resulting from any accident, damage, or injury occurring while undertaking business activities at the fashion parade/runway show
- 10.3 The trader agrees that the Council will have no responsibility or liability for any loss or damage to the trader's garments, fixtures or fittings or personal property

11. Cancellation

If the event is cancelled at any stage the Council shall not be liable for any expenditure or liability or loss including consequential loss incurred by the trader
